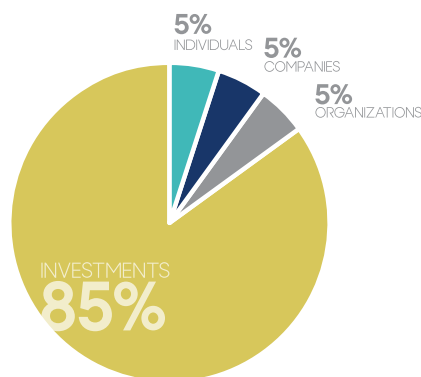

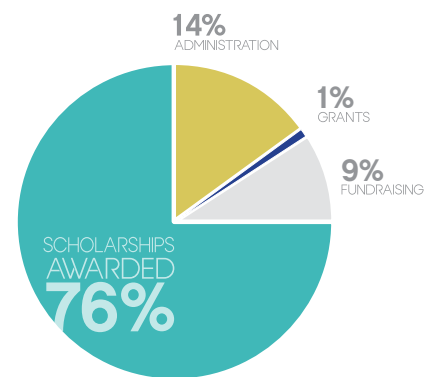
## PGSF operates under the control of a board of directors
