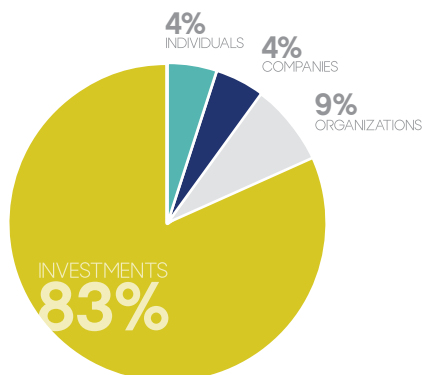

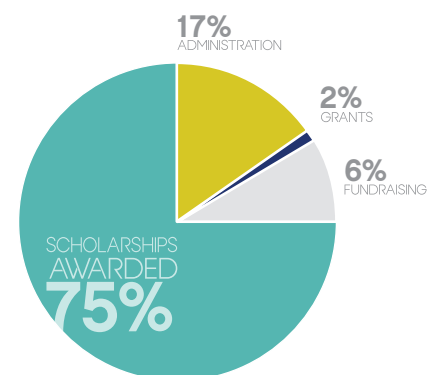
PGSF prioritizes maximizing awards and minimizing expenses
